### Transition of Care (TRC): All 4 components in OP medical record

**Applicable to: Mercy Care Advantage** 

The goal of this HEDIS measure is to promote safe transitions with post-discharge engagement and medication reconciliation supported by notification of admission and receipt of discharge information.

**Documentation for all 4 TRC components must be found in the OP (Outpatient) medical record** belonging to the member's PCP or ongoing care provider: included are records accessible in shared EMRs or obtained via portals and HIE (Health Information Exchange).

TRC Components + Specifications

#### **Notification of Inpatient Admission**

Documentation of admission must be filed or documented in the OP medical record within a 3-day timeframe, including the day of admission.

Types of documents found in the OP record that help capture compliance

- → ADT/HIE admission alerts (documented in OP record)
- → BHT, CM notes regarding admission (BH/Integrated Clinic)
- → Pre-op clearance or planned admission notes
- → Mercy Care Notification of Admission
- → Hospital records: H&Ps, IP consults

TIP: Sign up for ADT/HIE\* admission alerts and document in the OP medical record

### **Receipt of Discharge Information**

Documentation of discharge information must be filed in the OP medical record within a 3-day timeframe, including the day of discharge.

- → Discharge summaries with a clear date of receipt
- → Clear date of receipt: a print or fax date OR an attached scan or upload date e.g., HIE records
- → Continuity of Care documents are **NOT** accepted for TRC

TIP: Use ADT/HIE\* discharge alerts to help obtain discharge summaries timely

## **Patient Engagement Post-Discharge**

- see Applicable Codes\*\*

Documentation of engagement provided within **30 days** after discharge.

→ Office visits, in-home visits, telehealth, telephone or virtual check-ins, and consults

## Medication Reconciliation Post-Discharge - see Applicable Codes\*\*

Documentation of reconciliation on date of discharge through 30 days after discharge (include a list of current meds)

- → Office visits, consults
- → Discharge summaries
- → Transition Care Calls with a med review: only providers able to complete or sign off are an RN, prescribing provider, or pharmacist

Tip: Document provider awareness of "admission" or "hospitalization" in post-discharge visit
